- The qualifying age for tennis red tournaments is Under 8 from 1st January 2010-**therefore you must be born in the year 2002.**
- The qualifying age for tennis orange tournaments is Under 9 from 1st January 2010 -**therefore you must be born in the year 2001.**
- The qualifying age for tennis green tournaments is under 10 from 1st January 2010-**therefore you must be born in the year 2000.**
- In all these events you must play in the appropriate age group unless you hold a current TI passport (please see http://www.tennisireland.ie/players/juniors/player_passport for details) i.e. If you were born in 2001 you must play in the orange tournament unless you have a TI passport to play in a green event. If you were born in 2002 you must play in the red tournament unless you have a TI passport to play in an orange event.
