RULES & GUIDANCE

There will be five categories for Tennis 10s and some matches will take place under a bubble or indoors, but there will also be outdoor courts used.

RED 1: children born in 2011 or earlier who play 3 hours or more per week. RED 2 children who play red ball in their clubs 1 or 2 hours per week ORANGE 1: children born in 2010 who play 3 hours or more per week ORANGE 2: children who play orange ball in their clubs 1 or 2 hours per week: GREEN 1: children born in 2009 who play 3 hours or more per week GREEN 2: children who play green ball in their clubs 1 or 2 hours per week.

Tennis Tweens: For recreational yellow ball players aged between 10-13 years.

To register for an event a parent must enter online at the link provided. If the child turns up on the day hoping to join in, they will likely be disappointed.

Red ball events can have 16 children per full sized court, using 4 mini red courts across the main court. One match on, one match off. First to 10 points using alternating serving.

Orange and green ball events can have 4 children per full sized court, as all singles matches will use just one court, with masking tape used for orange lines. Matches will be short and timed with proper scoring; one match on and one match off.

All entries are £5 and should be paid in cash to the organiser on the day before play begins.

Please take careful note of the dates and times for the event you are entering, and we would ask that you give a minimum of 48 hours notice if your child is then unable to attend otherwise we would have to ask you for the entry fee.
